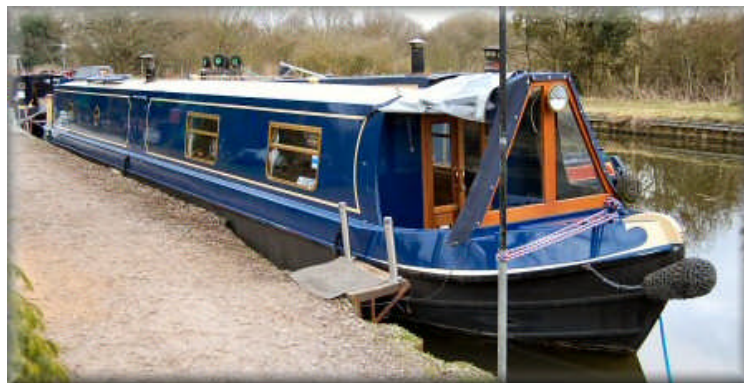

History

The vessel was purchased by the current owner in 2007, and is now being sold prior to the purchase of a larger vessel.

Hull & Exterior.

Material / build: All steel. *Thicknesses:* 10mm / 6mm / 4 mm



Exterior: Black bitumen painted hull to rubbing band. Dark blue from rubbing band through side decks and cabin sides. Roof in cream. Cream coachline on cabin sides, and cream detailing on bow and stern.

Windows: Brass anodised top hopper opening, 3 to port and 2 to starboard, plus two opening portholes aft each side.

Forward well: Rope fender. 'T' stud. Steel cants. Storage locker in bow. Fully glazed cratch with tunnel light mounted thereon. Blue cratch cover by Wilsons with zip up side doors and see through panels. Self draining forward well deck with inspection hatch for integral water tank below. Steel / timber seats/lockers to either side. Two centrally mounted half glazed varnished hardwood doors to accommodation.

Cabin 1: Double Cabin. Step in from aft deck. To port is a cupboard unit containing electrical distribution systems. Opposite is a storage unit with hanging rail. Steps turning to starboard lead down to floor level. The double bed is to port against the forward bulkhead with interior sprung mattress measuring 6ft 6ins x 4ft. Pull out drawer storage below berth. At the foot of the bed to port is a small dresser unit with three drawers and high

level storage unit over. Antique style radiator on hull side. Passageway to starboard leads forward with leading off:

Cabin 2: Bathroom. Door into bathroom which is finished in varnished oak as is the rest of the craft. Thetford electric flush cassette toilet. Modern towel rail in blue. $\frac{3}{4}$ size bath with shower head and chromium plated circular shower enclosure with curtain. Blue tiling with contrasting decorative 'dado' tile around bath area. Mirror on hull side. Surface mounted white china hand basin on top of hardwood storage unit. Decorative stained glass feature to the bulkhead. The passageway continues forward into:



Cabin 3: Galley. The galley is primarily to port with solid hardwood oiled work surfaces and cream 'shaker' style cupboards and drawers below. White composite sink inset into work surface with antique bronze style mixer tap. Shelving and plate storage against the aft bulkhead. The diesel fired Heritage Host Aga style range, which provides hot water and central heating, is mounted against the aft bulkhead. To port is a matching section of work surface with a full size LEC 240v

refrigerator mounted and 240v Whirlpool washing machine below. Opening side doors over fridge housing. A full height $\frac{1}{3}$ rd width bulkhead separates the galley from:



Cabin 4: Saloon. When sold the saloon will be unfurnished. Against the aft bulkhead is a built in single seating unit with table. Against the forward bulkhead to port is a Morso solid fuel stove on black stone hearth with tiled rear and side. To starboard is a low level storage unit with cupboard below. Step with storage up to forward well.
