History

This vessel has sold by ourselves twice previously, once in 2004, and again to the current owner in 2007. She was last out of the water in November 2008, when the hull was repainted with bitumen.

Hull & Exterior.

Material / build: All steel. Thicknesses: 10mm x 6mm x 4mm



Exterior: Black bitumen painted hull to rubbing band. Maroon from rubbing band, through side decks and cabin sides. Cream roof.

Windows: Brass anodised aluminium top hopper opening, 2 each side plus brass anodised aluminium framed portholes aft. Opening side doors either side of the galley, with lift up hatch over those to port.

Forward well: Bow fender. 'T' stud. Steel cants. Gas locker containing 2 x 13kg gas bottles. Glazed cratch with PVC Everflex type overall cover. Self draining well deck in steel with inspection hatch over integral water tank located under. Two steel doors, internally wooden lined, and two thirds glazed fitted centrally in the forward bulkhead with a non-opening brass anodised aluminium framed window each side.

Roof: Integral steel handrails. 7 brass mushroom vents. Centre eye. Fender eyes are fitted on the edge of the roof inside the handrail. Sliding hatch over access aft

Aft deck: Rope fender. Diesel filler. Two mooring dollies. Steel cants. Tiller steering with brass tiller sleeve. Flush fitting lift up steel hatch giving access to release weed hatch. Two steel doors internally wooden lined with large sliding steel hatch over fitted centrally in the aft bulkhead. 240v input socket.

Interior.

Lining - floor to gunwale: Combination of oak faced and carpeted panelling.
Lining - gunwale to ceiling: Varnished and routed tongue & grooved Piranha pine.
Lining - ceiling: Varnished oak faced panelling with contrasting varnished mahogany beams.
Bulkheads: Varnished oak faced panelling.

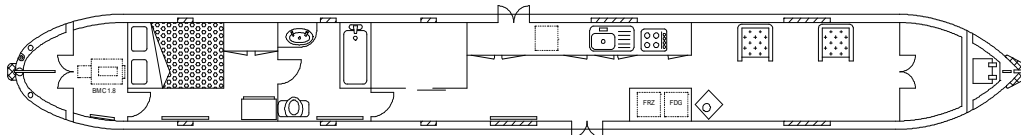
Flooring: Timber laminate throughout.
Lighting: Surface mount tungsten and additional wall lamps.

Cabin heating Morso solid fuel stove with back boiler and gravity fed radiators.
Insulation: Polystyrene
Water heating Morco gas water heater
Water system: 12v pressurised.

Headroom: 6ft 2ins to underside of beams in the saloon and 6ft 3ins to the ceiling.

Cabin Arrangement: Engine Room / Double Berth Cabin / Bathroom / Spare Cabin / Galley / Saloon



Berth arrangement: 2 berth: permanent double berth in own cabin.

Cabin 1: Engine Room. Fully lined with the engine fully enclosed. Door to starboard with step down into

Cabin 2: Double Cabin. Double berth to port with interior sprung mattress which extends out to 5ft (5ft x 6ft 3ins). Storage below. At the forward end on the starboard side is a freestanding set of small drawers. Double width full height cupboard with hanging rail fitted along the port side at the forward end. Radiator to starboard on the hull side. Central door leads into

Cabin 3: Bathroom. 'Walk through' bathroom with bath in white and hand held shower attachment. Wash hand basin set into a tiled vanity unit with cupboard under. Wall mounted mirror. Thetford cassette toilet. Morco room sealed gas water heater fitted on the aft bulkhead. Radiator on the starboard hull side. Door to starboard leads into corridor with sliding door off into

Cabin 4: :Spare Cabin. Leading off the corridor this cabin is empty and could be used for a single berth, twin bunks, or as an office / work room. The corridor continues into

Cabin 5: Galley. The walk through galley is fitted on both sides with black granite effect work surface with pine cupboards and drawers under. To starboard is a full size Beko 240v refrigerator, and matching freezer. Sharp 'combi' microwave. To port is an Candy automatic washing machine / drier. Four burner gas hob in stainless steel with glass cover. Vanette GG6000 grill and oven below. Trademark 'circular archway' into



Cabin 6 Saloon. The saloon is open plan and is designed to take free standing furniture which currently comprises 2 armchairs and a freestanding TV unit in pine. The Morso solid fuel stove is fitted on a ceramic tiled hearth with ceramic tiling behind and alongside. Under gunnel bookshelves o starboard. Opening locker / step to forward well.
